Commitment to Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions

We are continually working to minimise our environmental footprint and reduce greenhouse gas emissions across the resort

- **Solar Energy**: We utilise solar power extensively throughout the property, including walkway lighting, pier illumination, and landscape uplighting.
- **Water Management**: The resort operates its own wastewater treatment plant, ensuring responsible water use and safe discharge.
- **Reducing Single-Use Plastics**: We have introduced an in-house drinking water bottling system using recyclable glass bottles to significantly reduce plastic waste.
- **Global Environmental Participation**: Each year, we take part in World Cleanup Day on 18 September and Earth Hour, when the resort is illuminated by candles arranged in the shape of the Earth.
- **Tree Planting**: We actively participate in Cambodia's National Tree Planting Day, reinforcing our commitment to reforestation and habitat enrichment.
- Sustainable Dining: To support our emissions-reduction goals, we are expanding our vegetarian offerings and replacing selected meat dishes

We strongly encourage all current and future island developments to adopt similar environmental standards to help preserve Koh Rong for generations to come.

- We conduct regular beach cleaning activities to remove debris drifting into Kampong Som Bay, helping protect our pristine shoreline.
- To avoid causing disturbance or harm to marine life, motorised water sports such as jet skis are not permitted.
- We continue to enhance the resort's natural environment through ongoing tree planting and landscaping initiatives.

Our goal is to ensure that every aspect of our operations supports the long-term health of our island's marine and terrestrial ecosystems.
